The following omissions have been discovered since *Maine Children's Mental Health 2006* went to press. There will not be another printing of this edition of the report. The pdf document has been updated as of March 23, 2007, and includes the information that was omitted in the first printing of the report.

Page	Omissions
6	In the table titled PROTECTIVE FACTORS, the date (2003) was not included in each of the three indicators in the table.
7	In the table titled PARENTS' PERCEPTIONS, the date (2003) was not included in each of the indicators. In addition, the universe that the percent was based on is not identified, as has been done for all of the other indicators. The universe for each of the indicators is the age group of children identified in the indicator.
10	The acronym SED is not identified in the table titled AVAILABLE DATA IN THE PUBLIC SYSTEMS. SED stands for serious emotional disturbance.
14 & 15	Under the list of mental health services, the acronym for ACT is not identified in the table titled UTILIZATION. ACT stands for Assertive Community Treatment.
32 & 33	For the indicators under CHILD WELL-BEING INDICATORS, PROTECTIVE FACTORS AND PARENTS' PERCEPTIONS, the year (2003) was not included in each of the eight indicators.
